***Note:** The NATO Status of Forces Agreement (SOFA) between Italy and the United States prohibits the hiring of any person who holds Italian citizenship and is considered a Dual National by the Italian Government into any U.S. position. Those U.S. citizens who are considered "ordinarily resident" in Italy are also ineligible for employment by U.S. commands and activities in Italy.*

### INTRODUCTION

The purpose of this position is to perform routine grounds keeping, labor, and maintenance task as necessary. The work sites is located mainly at the Olde Mill Inn Park Complex and occasionally at the MWR location at Fleet Landing.

### DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Performs minor repairs associated with Electrical, plumbing, painting, masonry, carpentry and air conditioning trades in compliance with maintenance and upkeep of all facilities of the MWR Dept., Naval Support Activity. Makes minor electrical repairs, minor repairs to the refrigeration and air conditioning equipment, changing and cleaning filters, relays, thermostats, etc. Repairs and /or replaces, as necessary, ballcock, assembly, flush meters, faucets and washers, clears and cleans drains, and repairs broken water lines, repairs minor damage to work, adjusts and repairs doors and windows, and replaces window glass. Performs masonry, duties such as making small repairs to floors, walls, ceilings, sidewalks and roads. Mixes cements, mortar and plaster to meet acceptable trade standards. Basic repairs and maintenance, tasks are performed independently only minimum supervision.

Performs routine ground-keeping task; performs manual labor work by moving, loading, and unloading heavy material, digging trenches, cleaning the pavilions washing down outside areas.

## QUALIFICATIONS & REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must at minimum meet the Screen-out elements and the applicants' work experience description must demonstrate possession of the following Screen-Out Elements:

1. Must have a valid driver's license and be able to learn to drive a truck up to 2 tons, forklift, and tractor;
2. Must be knowledgeable of and use all fire and other safety precautions as required;
3. Should be able to learn to draw an arc and weld items with a proper joint and light torch, and adjust flame and cut metal.

- **Applicants who hold both U.S. and Italian citizenship are not employable by the U.S. Forces in Italy.**
- **Effective 01 April 2009**, applicants applying for any **TEMPORARY** position **MUST** complete the Form for Temporary Employment (modulo aggiuntivo per impiego temporaneo).
- Eligibility and consideration is limited to qualified applicants who can serve the temporary appointment timeframe and be released at the end of the temporary appointment period without exceeding an aggregate of 24 months of temporary employment performing equivalent duties.
