Accelerated Withdrawal

Nov. 29, 2023 and May 7, 2024--DoDEA Principals may authorize the accelerated withdrawal of active duty military and Department of Defense civilian dependent students from school 20 or fewer instructional days prior to the end of a semester. This provision is not intended to apply to, or be extended for, the convenience of family travel, visits or other discretionary reasons. The policy therefore requires verification of the date of the sponsor's departure, i.e., PCS or other official orders, to school officials to receive consideration for full academic credit.

PCS-ing **out** soon?

Are you PCS-ing during the school year and need guidance on the withdrawal process? Please contact the Naples Middle High School registrar and/or the Naples Elementary School registrar for information on how to get started. Notice should be provided at least two weeks prior to the last day of student attendance.

Educational Advisory Committees

We want to hear from you!

The School Advisory Committee (SAC) may make recommendations and advise the principal on all matters within the jurisdiction of the SAC; these include:

- (a) School policies towards students and parents, student activities, and administrative procedures affecting students.
- (b) Instructional programs and educational resources within the school.
- (c) Allocation of resources within the school to achieve educational goals.
- (d) Pupil services (health, special education, testing, evaluation, counseling, and extracurricular activities).
- (e) Student standards of conduct and discipline.

The Installation Advisory Committee (IAC) may make recommendations and advise the installation commander within the jurisdiction of the IAC:

- (a) Quality, availability, maintenance, safety, security, and comfort of the physical school environment.
- (b) Transportation of students.
- (c) School meal programs.
- (d) Medical services.
- (e) Administrative and logistical support services provided by the relevant installation commander and the Military Department command concerned.

SACs and IACs do not address matters pertaining to policies or practices, compensation of school staff, grievances of school employees for which another forum exists, or internal management of DoDEA or DoDEA programs.
