Scholarships for Military Children-Fisher House Foundation

Due date is Feb. 16 at 8:59 a.m. Naples time.

Five hundred (500) scholarship grants, each for \$2,000, will be awarded for the academic school year 2023-2024. There is at least one recipient selected at every commissary location where qualified applications are received.

Only students with valid Uniformed Services Identification (USID) card may apply for a scholarship. In addition, a student's parent(s) must be one of the following: active duty, reserve/guard, deceased, or retired from the Army, Marine Corps, Navy, Air Force, Coast Guard, or Space Force.
