SY 2023-2024 New Student Registration (DoDEA)

Parents must register new student individually by logging into the DoDEA Student Information System (DSIS) Family Portal at https://dodeasis.myfollett.com/aspen/logon.do and submitting a student registration request "Please make sure to choose SY 2023-2024."

Verification of the following is required for those overseas:

- Date of Birth
- Dependent Status
- Active-Duty Status of Military Sponsor or Employment Status of Civilian Sponsor
- Status of Defense Contractor Sponsor and Central Billing Letter
- Status of non-DoD sponsor (other Federal Agencies)
- Immunization record
- School records
- ***Notify the school site registrar upon completion of the above

SY 2023-2024 Re-registration (DoDEA)

Parents must re-register each student individually by logging into the DoDEA Student Information System (DSIS) Family Portal at

https://dodeasis.myfollett.com/aspen/logon. do and submitting a student re-registration request. The re-registration process provides a quick and easy way for families to update information (contacts, Sponsor's employment status, student health) and indicate whether their student will be returning or withdrawing next school year.

Parents are encouraged to complete the reregistration process as soon as possible, but no later than the end of the school year. After your re-registration submission has been reviewed, the School Registrar will contact you if additional information is required.
