

Catacombs of Naples



This interesting, and somewhat macabre tour, takes you through the Catacombs of San Gaudioso and the Catacombs of San Gennaro. See the many tombs and well-preserved frescos from the fifth and sixth centuries under the Basilica of Santa Maria della Guadoso, near Capodimonte, and the Madonna della Sanita, the oldest depiction of the Virgin Mary in Campania. The Catacombs of San Gennaro were the preferred burial place of Roman noblemen and for some time also held the remains of San Gennaro, the city's patron saint.
