General Policy Guidance:

- DoDEA AI 1358.01 Section 5: District or Installation Advisory Committees and Regional Advisory Committees
- · A DAC, IAC, or RAC may be established if a military installation or district or region leadership deems one is necessary
- NSA Naples is establishing an IAC to support local DODEA

Mission:

• The IAC will advise the ICO and DoDEA leadership on issues concerning students' education within the installation

Function:

- Discuss issues affecting, or that can affect the educational environment
- The IAC may make recommendations and advise the district and region regarding support provided by the Military Service to the DoDEA schools being supported
- DoDEA administrators and military commanders may use DODEA and CNIC leadership to foster communication, facilitate problem solving, and recommend action to appropriate officials

Naples School Liaison Report



- Parent Solution and Support Groups—MFLC supported, DoDEA developing
 - MFLCs--Working for new school year roll-out in September; 4 returning (3-NES, 1-NMHS) and 5 new (1-NES, 2—NMHS, 2-CYP)
 - DoDEA—NES providing "Avoiding the Summer Slide" at Move Up event
- Naples Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT)
 - Naples MDT has been development, publicity flyer in production with Marketing Department
- Free- and Reduced-Meal Program
 - Applications open online July 1
 - Messaging available at the end of June, also released at school start and periodically through the year over a multitude of platforms and venues
 - Publicity flyer has been released and in conjunction with information pricing, accounts, payments, etc.

Old Business



- Minutes from 09APR25 meeting posted Naples CYP FB page, SL webpage, and NMHS FB page: closed
- School Lunches: open
 - Follow-up on concerns regarding contract bids and oversight by NEX. Still awaiting a copy of the contract from NEX to ensure vendor is meeting the stated contract requirements, length of contract, etc. Can the NEX align more with AAFES for their menu ideas which would have to be approved by the USDA as well? See photos from a concerned parent of a Naples Lunch and AAFES school menu from other school in Italy as well as pictures of their lunch and ala carte options.
 - Per the School Meal Program (SMP) requirements, the NEX contracts out, vendor follows USDA program, DoDEA benefits from using.
 - NEX needs to execute to the fullest potential and hold contractor accountable, weekly unannounced visits are occurring, strong emphasis on quality services is being provided, discrepancies have been communicated, and handled through corrective actions and course corrections.
 - Goal—improve remainder of current school year and start next year on point, create MOU between NEX and DoDEA in Naples.
 - Current vendor contract information cannot be shared.
 - NEX will compare SMP NEX contract with AAFES and BX and report at next IAC. Follow up: AAFES follows same program but are direct run versus approved source ordering.
 - NEX will place QR codes, drop boxes for direct student and parent feedback, Microsoft forms were recommended
 - NEX will consider using photo cards and cafeteria t.v. to share what the plates should look like upon receipt in the lunch line as well as pricing.
 - NEX will observe length of lunch lines to ensure students have enough time to eat. Follow-up observations have confirmed.
 - How is vendor English language testing verified? Testing not a requirement, hold accountable through verification. Follow-up verification has occurred.
 - After speaking with the SMP Food services specialist at HQ, AAFES direct runs all their SMP operations (with the exception of Turkey) which enables them to have more control with ordering and oversight. Purchasing from approved sources leads to difficulties OCONUS.
- Update on EFMP and Overseas Screening Process: Challenges with both active duty and civilian families arriving without completing, enrolling and communicating in advance of arrival: closed
 - Many meetings between Installation School Liaison, Installation and Region EFMP and DoDEA Naples and District Instructional Specialists where communication needs, language and processes were identified. Executable updates were made for incoming families. Data and concerns have been elevated to Region (Navy and DoDEA). Issues are consistent with other installations, service branches and past history. HQs are aware and tracking.
 - See DoDI 1342.12m for both active duty and civilian sponsors/students

Old Business (continued)



- Concerns for facilities at NMHS: One outer door has not been properly fixed for at least 30 days, work order was submitted: closed
 - DoDEA, Public Works, Mirabella and the Installation CO are all aware, chain is being used to secure door during off-school hours, part has been ordered and awaiting arrival, maximum effort is in effect on the installation side, doing all allowed within contract, PW is withholding funds due to lack of timely repair
 - No current safety concerns
 - Recommend alternative methods to acquire part, recommend Mod 14 contract change, recommend buzzers when doors open
 - It was found that the work order was placed 10 Mar 2025 and the repair was completed 11 Apr 2025. Additional parts are in stock for any future needs.
- Concerns for school site kitchen issues: unresolved and unclogged sinks and drains: closed
 - Concerns regarding the quality of repairs
 - PW has assigned Seabees' for checks and support
