

The Family Advocacy Program (FAP) provides a consistent, standardized response to incidents of child or domestic abuse. NSA Naples wants you to know your role, rights and responsibilities.

Your Role

Help FAP with prevention of family maltreatment by knowing the resources and providing information to those around you.

Your Rights

As U.S. military, U.S. DoW civilians and U.S. contract staff and their family members, you are eligible for FAP services. Adult victims may choose to make a restricted report that allows supportive services without legal or command involvement. You have the right to safety and

NSA Naples is here to support with a 24/7 victim advocacy response capability and temporary lodging. The Family Advocacy Committee (FAC) is led by the NSA Naples Commanding Officer and meets regularly to review and make policy changes to address domestic and child abuse in our community.

Your Responsibilities

All personnel (unless precluded by professional privilege) report incidents or suspected incidents of child and domestic abuse to FAP or NSA Naples Security.
