Student Meal Accounts

All students are eligible to participate in the NEX Student Meal Program. At no time will students be denied their first complete school meal, regardless of account balance. A positive student meal account balance must be maintained for students to purchase second meals and extra (a la carte) items.

Sponsors remain financially responsible for all meals served to your students. Ensure your students have sufficient funds in their student meal account if participating in the student meal program to avoid the collection process of accounts in arrears.
