School (DoDEA) Meal Readiness

- 1. Register each student with DoDEA (New Students)
 - Obtain 10-digit DoDEA Student ID# from school registrar
 - You will need each student's ID# for Step 3
- 2. Register your Family on LINQ Connect (Optional)
 - Make online payments for each student's meal accounts
 - Remotely monitor student accounts and set parental restrictions
 - Set up automatic recurring payments
 - Submit an online application for free or reduced meals
- 3. Options for depositing money into your student's account
 - Make deposits at your local NEX Customer Service
 - Add money to your student's account online (\$2.60 bank convenience fee each time. To save on processing fees, make one payment and transfer funds from one student account to another.)
- 4. Start here to submit your SY24-25 application
 - Apply at https://lingconnect.com (DoDEA Alexandria, VA)
 - Follow Tip Sheet for items to include and exclude (see Tip Sheet at www.navymwrnaples.com/child-youth/school-liaison)
 - A new application is required for each school year and each move

Graduation

- Waiving courses required for graduation if similar coursework has been completed
- Flexibility in accepting state exit or end-of-course exams, national achievement tests, or alternative testing in lieu of testing requirements for graduation in the receiving state
- Allowing a student to receive a diploma from the sending school instead of the receiving

Homeschool Info

Homeschooling is the practice of opting to teach one's own children at home via parents, tutors, or virtual programs instead (or in lieu) of sending them to school.

DoDEA offers up to three classes in person and also access to auxiliary services, academic resources, extracurricular activities, interscholastic (athletic or academic) activities and special education services to homeschoolers. See www.dodea.edu/home-schooling.



CHILD CARE OPTIONS FOR AGES 4-12

UNIVERSAL PRE-KINDERGARTEN

Student must be 4 years old on or before Sept. 1 and enrolled in Universal Pre-Kindergarten to participate in "wrap-around" part-time care options.

Request "Pre-K Before and After School-DoDEA Universal PRE-K Only" care at www.militarychildcare.com.

Child care provided at Support Site or Capodichino Child Development Centers (CDC).

Fee is based on Total Family income fee table.

SCHOOL AGE CARE

Child care provided at Support Site School Age Care (SAC).

Request "Before and After School Care" at www.militarychildcare.com.

Students must be enrolled and attending Kindergarten to attend SAC.

Fee is based on Total Family Income fee table.

CONDITIONAL ENROLLMENT

Select courses and build a class schedule prior to arrival at your next school!

DoDEA Europe high schools are offering conditional enrollment to militaryconnected students due to Permanent Change of Station orders.

- 1 COURSE SELECTION
- 2 COMMUNICATE WITH
- 3 CONNECT WITH SCHOOL

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for conditional enrollment, the student must:

- Meet Eligibility requirements for space required enrollment.
- Be requesting enrollment into grades 9-12
- Arrive at assigned duty station within three-months of requesting conditional enrollment
- Provide current report card and transcript to complete conditional enrollment
