IV. NMHS Report

Facilities

- NMHS External Doors Replacement Phase 1 installation to being October Phase 2 installation to begin March 2026
- HS Gym Bleacher Wheels have been installed, but motors are not operable. Motors are not covered by Mirabella. DODEA will have to purchase and Mirabella can install. HS Gym Bleacher extend/retract motors need repair, however, the bleachers can be pushed in and out manually.
- o Gym Lighting Replacement of 13 gym lights completed by the time of this meeting.
- Culinary Arts Program Upgrade: Working with the fire inspector to revise the scope and resubmit the TF1 for code compliance.
- The NSA Naples Commanding Officer addressed stadium lights and stated that the permits for these lights are being worked in close coordination with the City of Gricignano. Upon receipt of the permits, contracts for the lights would be actioned. He further discussed the intent to construct a field house in the vicinity of the stadium as well.

- Morning Supervision. Teachers and Staff have been supporting student safety through coordinated staging throughout front and back of school. This is in replacement of last year's student led Safety Patrol.

VI. Commanding Officer Report

Traffic Safety update

NSA Naples is responsible for infrastructure upgrades, traffic control and enforcement. Changes to Infrastructure to include raised crosswalk, removal of part of sidewalk, and movable vehicle barriers (swing arm or improved chains) are out for Request for Proposal. Plans to request funding to complete work Summer 2026. Until permanent changes occur, ICO and DODEA have developed a plan to place barrier during AM drop off and PM pick up. No vehicles are to enter area near busses, nor should any community member move the barriers.

Non-DODEA Facilities updates

Top Priorities and Specific Issues Priority 1: Post Office (MOD 73) - Phase II started 29SEP Priority 2: DoDEA Bleacher wheels, HS gym lights, HVAC Annex 1 COMPLETE Priority: 3 Base-wide beautification. Random junk pile(s) (abandoned cars, furniture, debris, etc.) removal, common area restrooms, bus stop clean up Priority 4: Restructure EOM/LTMRR meeting Priority 5: MODs in delay. Beautification (MOD 75), Fire House Fence (MOD 71)

Mirabella is significantly behind on repairs across the base, as well as on preventive maintenance. These concerns have been elevated.

NSA Naples Manning update

Installation Manning 54.7%; Housing Staff 44%; Fire 35%; MWR 77%

New Safety Director (geared focus toward school traffic safety) and Housing Director onboarding.

Furlough impact is minimal unless answer required from outside the Command, if goes past 30 days we will see in direct impacts.

- Naples Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT)
 - Naples MDT instruction is in development. Marketing will be developed once instruction is approved.
- Free- and Reduced-Meal Program
 - Application are being processed as they are received.
 - Income verification is occurring through CNIC. If your family is selected, you must respond in a timely manner, or risk being removed from program.

IX. Old Business

- School Lunches: propose to send back to SAC w/ out further complaints or desired changes by DODEA-Closed
 - NEX, School Liaison, and parents met in Spring 2025. Current contractor will remain for SY 25/26, with changes to menu. Continuing to assess quality and quantity of food provided. No complaints have been received as of 17 October 2025.
- Update on EFMP and Overseas Screening Process: Challenges with both active duty and civilian families arriving without completing, enrolling and communicating in advance of arrival: Closed
 - Many meetings between Installation School Liaison, Installation and Region EFMP and DoDEA Naples and District Instructional Specialists where communication needs, language and processes were identified. Executable updates were made for incoming families. Data and concerns have been elevated to Region (Navy and DoDEA). Issues are consistent with other installations, service branches and past history. HQs are aware and tracking.
 - See DoDI 1342.12m for both active duty and civilian sponsors/students
 - Continues to be a concern with DOD Civilians and Contractors, being unaware of process.
- Concerns for school bathrooms: unresolved and unclogged plumbing and smells from drains: Closed
 - Any ongoing request for repairs will be handled through TF1. Schools will market to student/teachers the process
 - o If repair is not satisfactory, school will ask for QA with PW
- Concerns regarding off site sporting events and reasonable breaks from bussing:
 open
 - Per regulations, busses will stop every 2-3 hours for comfort stops and driver breaks.
 - o Principal will remind coaches and drivers of this regulation.
 - Principal will research the contract for off-site busses. Can students use bathroom on the bus?
- o Concerns regarding HS Gym usage by other students than Football players: open
 - Any student athletic group can use the weight room, by requesting time through Athletic Director
 - Accommodation have been made by MWR Gym to allow student usage after school. Many coaches and athletes prefer MWR Gym and weight equipment
 - MWR is going to old equipment.
 - School will research "Beaver Fit Box" to supplement current workout spaces.
 NSA Naples can assist with process of purchase and placement of box, if ordered.
 - Mirabella is to fund new Field House with Gym which will allow greater access CY26

X. New Business

- Stadium Lights: (Open) Student rep Self asked about Stadium Lights and timeline for repairs. CO explained they are awaiting permits from local authorities.
- College scholarships/processes: (Open) Student rep Matera asked about more information about college/scholarships/processes. Principal Beane talked about process counselor follow of individual tracking, planning, and support.

 Specific Parent question (closed): Parent expressed concerns about her son's access to services, following a move. Parent will put concerns in writing to both school and school liaison, for clarity of concern and processes.
