Castles of Naples



Take a day to visit three important castles of Naples. Castel St. Elmo dates back to the 14th century and sits high on a dominating hill overlooking the city. Through the years it offered fortification to the city and has also been used as a prison. The Maschio Angioino, also known as "Castel Nuovo", dates back to 1279. Due to its location between the port and the Royal Palace, it was used to guard the King's residence. As you learn its history, you will also visit the civic museum and the Baron's Hall. Sitting in the bay of Naples is the Castel dell'Ovo, the "Egg Castle", one of the city's most loved symbols. You'll be fascinated by the legend of this site while you admire the charming fishing village around its base.
