General Policy Guidance:

- DoDEA AI 1358.01 Section 5: District or Installation Advisory Committees and Regional Advisory Committees
- · A DAC, IAC, or RAC may be established if a military installation or district or region leadership deems one is necessary
- NSA Naples is establishing an IAC to support local DODEA

Mission:

• The IAC will advise the ICO and DoDEA leadership on issues concerning students' education within the installation

Function:

- Discuss issues affecting, or that can affect the educational environment
- The IAC may make recommendations and advise the district and region regarding support provided by the Military Service to the DoDEA schools being supported
- DoDEA administrators and military commanders may use DODEA and CNIC leadership to foster communication, facilitate problem solving, and recommend action to appropriate officials

Student Report



11th/12th grade student to provide update to community on IAC items

- Water fountains
 - Concern: Would be nice to have water bottle dispensaries near the gym and restrooms
 - Response: Three have been ordered
- Track repair timeline
 - Concern: When scheduling repairs it is inconvenient during sports seasons and timelines often extend past deadlines
 - Response: Needs to be approved with FY26 money, strategic about scheduling with plan to contract during summer months
- School lunches
 - Concern: Many do not look appealing, fries are wet and not good for athletes, portion sizes are not filling
 - Response: See Old Business slide, School lunch (open) topic
- Restrooms
 - Concern: Harsh markings left on walls by students, how can they be caught and held accountable?
 - Response: Anonymous reporting app usage by students would help administration hold students accountable
- Gym under bleachers
 - Concern: Only the football team is allowed to use, it is also locked, other team coaches may not be advocating for
 - Response: Admin was not aware and will need to look into the matter

Traffic Safety update

- On pause, no Safety Officer
- Tentative plans include restriping curbs, demolishing center concrete curb, and inserting swing arm to replace the chains across the roadway

Non-DODEA Facilities updates

- Permits approved for work to move forward upcoming: field house, field lighting

- In progress: Dog park and pickle ball court
- Bike shelters are currently being installed

Naples School Liaison Report



- Parent Solution and Support Groups—MFLC supported, DoDEA developing
 - MFLCs--Working for new school year roll-out in September; 4 returning (3-NES, 1-NMHS) and 5 new (1-NES, 2—NMHS, 2-CYP)
 - DoDEA—NES providing "Avoiding the Summer Slide" at Move Up event
- Naples Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT)
 - Naples MDT has been development, publicity flyer in production with Marketing Department
- Free- and Reduced-Meal Program
 - Applications open online July 1
 - Messaging available at the end of June, also released at school start and periodically through the year over a multitude of platforms and venues
 - Publicity flyer has been released and in conjunction with information pricing, accounts, payments, etc.
- School Liaison position transition
 - Incoming School Liaison is awaiting visa, which has been communicated that it is in the mail. Optimistically hoping that a position gap will be potentially as minimal as three weeks.

Old Business



- Minutes from 09APR25 meeting posted Naples CYP FB page, SL webpage, and NMHS FB page: closed
- School Lunches: open
 - Follow-up on concerns regarding contract bids and oversight by NEX. Still awaiting a copy of the contract from NEX to ensure vendor is meeting the stated contract requirements, length of contract, etc. Can the NEX align more with AAFES for their menu ideas which would have to be approved by the USDA as well? See photos from a concerned parent of a Naples Lunch and AAFES school menu from other school in Italy as well as pictures of their lunch and ala carte options.
 - Recipe card does include instructions regarding how to cook the food and also how to utilize the equipment.
 - NEX needs to identify issues with related data. NEX will follow-up on this and report at the next IAC including summary with pictures as well as key performance indicators. Data topics will include: materials, consistency, education, etc.
 - NEX will compare SMP NEX contract with AAFES and BX and report at next IAC. Follow up: AAFES follows same program but are direct run versus approved source ordering.
 - Still pending: NEX will consider using photo cards and cafeteria t.v. to share what the plates should look like upon receipt in the lunch line as well as pricing.
 - NES does have staff taking photos of lunches. NMHS has a select group of students, due to verification requirements.
 - No current answer regarding whether or not NEX can have the same options as the AAFES contract.
 - DoDEA benefits for using NEX Student Meal Program (SMP) include a small percentage back from costs. DoDEA Europe South Community Superintendent states the money is not received locally and is not currently sure if Naples can switch.
 - If the NEX SMP were to be replaced, the free- and reduced-meal program (FARM) would not be available. Combination of two programs (FARM) and outside contract can be researched.
 - Recommend elevating portion size concerns to USDA.
 - Ship cooks (CS rates) were recommended to utilize. CO will give some consideration, potentially for partnership experiences.
 - Decision needs to be made if to keep vendor for next school year and have conversation for changing vendor and/or program.

Old Business (continued)



- New contracts can be open to any vendor/contractor. Food safety, conscious of guidelines and USDA portions are some components that must be considered when changing vendors/contractors.
- The Child Nutrition Specialist is located at the NEX Headquarters level for collaboration. Local preferences can be sent by DoDEA.
- Salad bar can be added to the contract as long as the modification follows guidelines.
- DoDEA HQ asks for contracted vendor, NEX becomes the Contract Officer Representative (COR).
- Contractor is monitored daily either in person or digitally by the Services Manager. Contractor must send pics each morning and afternoon of the days offerings and the line of food that has been prepared.
- Pictures must match the provided menu and recipe guides.
- Our greatest feedback is generated through students at the MHS. Pictures are provided daily. Issues have decreased but is not yet at 100%.
- Services Manager has met with the contract owner on several occasions to discuss the UNSAT service. Contract owner and the head Chef are committed to continued improvement.
- Issues proven and discussed include portion size, quality of product served, discrepancy to recipe, and overall service.
- We are still working through Contracting and Legal on an immediate feedback program that does not infringe on the contractors rights.

 Current NEX Food Survey QR Code does not include the School Meal Program.

Back to School Bash

- Concern: Organizations will not be able to outreach with families due to "rumor" of Back to School Bash cancellation
- Response: Back to School Bash is confirmed as not occurring. Organizations can provide information and food sales at NES and NMHS Open Houses, Sneak Peeks, etc. As the school sites host the opportunities.

Sixth grade field trip cancellation

- Concern: Sixth grade students did not have a planned field trip like other grade levels
- Response: Original Exception to Policy (ETP) trip was planned and approved, the grade level changed plans, the second plan was improperly submitted as another ETP, option for walking tour was provided, grade level made decision not to participate in option, communication was sent to sixth grade parents

NMHS events communicated to NES

 Recommendation: First, community/cross-share choir concerts and musicals so families may attend. Second, provide NFE opportunities to offer food and fundraise at concerts and shows. Last, NMHS performers collaborate with NES students/classes to create interest in study fields.
